INVITATION FOR BIDDER'S PRE-QUALIFICATION

MINERAL SPRINGS WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION TO 0.95 MGD

NEWNAN UTILITIES - CITY OF NEWNAN, GEORGIA

Separate sealed Bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for the MINERAL SPRINGS WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION TO 0.95 MGD are planned to be received by The Newnan Water, Sewerage and Light Commission (d.b.a., Newnan Utilities) late 2nd quarter of this calendar year.

The Project will generally consist of the following major components of work:

- a. New grit removal system;
- b. New secondary pump station;
- c. New deep bed filters;
- d. New cascade aeration structure;
- e. New bulk alum feed facilities;
- f. Existing control building upgrades;
- g. Miscellaneous piping upgrades and modifications; and
- h. Electrical and instrumentation upgrades and modifications.

Bidder Pre-Qualification: Pre-qualification of Bidders for the Project is required. Pre-qualification submittals will be received at the office of Wiedeman and Singleton, Inc. until 5:00 p.m., local time, Friday, April 14, 2017. All firms submitting a pre-qualification package will be notified of their status by no later than Friday, May 5, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. local time.

ONLY BIDS SUBMITTED BY PREVIOUSLY PRE-QUALIFIED BIDDERS WILL BE OPENED. Copies of Contract Documents will be made available at a later date. The work will be awarded in one Contract.

Each Bid will be required to be accompanied by a Bid Bond, prepared on the form of Bid Bond located in the Contract Documents or a Surety Company's Standard Bid Bond, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Georgia and listed in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, in the amount of 10 percent of the Bid.

The successful Bidder for this Contract will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of 100 percent of the Bid. Newnan Utilities reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive informalities and to re-advertise.
